## **Proposed Policy Statement**

#### A. Recommended Deactivation

Each year during the spring semester the Registrar's Office will provide to departments a list of undergraduate courses that have not been offered in the last five consecutive years for review.

If the department recommends that a course remain active, the dean's approval is required. Courses that do not receive dean approval are deactivated and can only be reinstated by going through the curriculum process.

#### B. Automatic Deactivation

Any undergraduate course that has not been offered in the last eight consecutive years will automatically be deactivated and removed from future catalogs.

A list of courses deactivated as a result of this process will be shared with the Dean and Program Directors. Once deactivated; a course can only be reinstated by going through the curriculum process.
