Original Policy Statement

Transcript(s) and/or diploma must meet United States high school equivalency standards. A completed document by document report is required. The student assumes all responsibility for costs associated with the evaluation.

Evaluations must be performed by a current National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES) member. Transcripts must be submitted directly to the Registrar's Office to be considered official.
